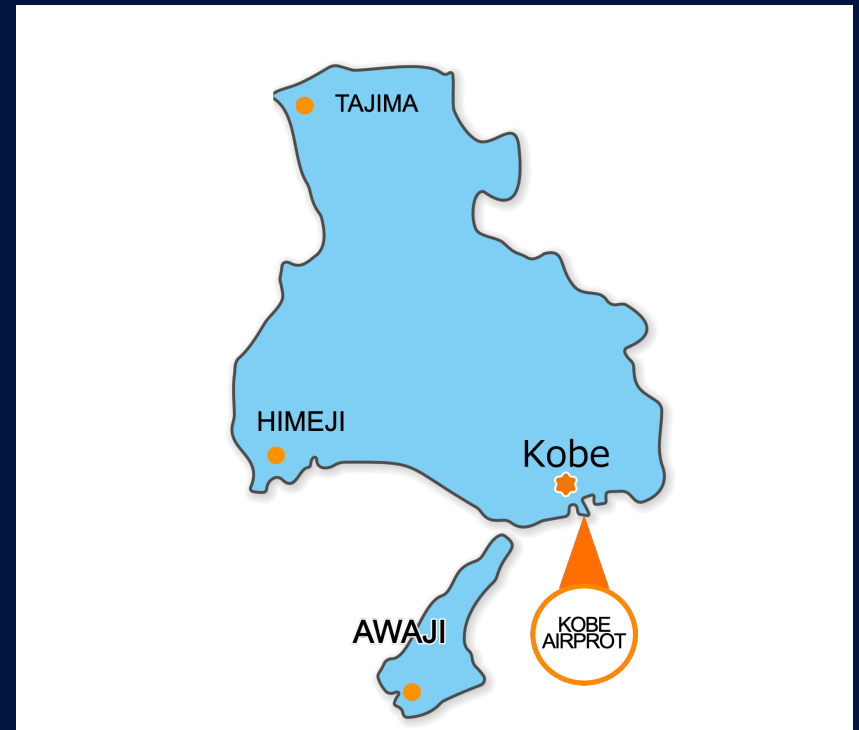
# About Hyogo Prefecture

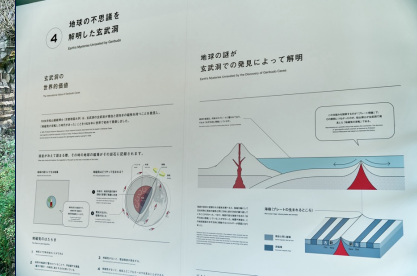

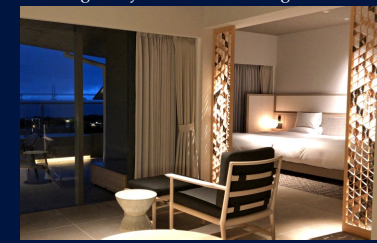
