Get lucky in Takarazuka, a hot spring resort in Hyogo Prefecture far from the crowds of inbound tourists.

Overview

A tour based in Takarazuka, which is sure to attract inbound visitors not only for its accessibility to and from the west but for the ability to experience FUKU (blessing culture) to its fullest. A culture whose source is good fortune and is said to be rooted in the origins of Japan as a nation.

Plan

1. Check-in at Ryokan “Hotel Wakamizu”

You will be showered with a lot of good fortune in a room with a layout of lucky charms (lucky winnowers, rakes, bales, treasure ships, frames, and squares) and a *suikin* (a water harp). Please also enjoy opening the original good luck bags placed on the table. We also recommend that you relax from the day's fatigue in the room bath with roses of auspicious red and other colors floating in the bathtub as soon as you arrive.

2. Private FUKU Kaiseki Dinner

A kaiseki dinner prepared with seasonal ingredients such as abalones and sekihan (red rice) which are believed to be good luck in respect to feng shui, will be served in a private dining room in your hotel. A sake tasting set is also available for guests to compare a variety of sake from Hyogo and other regions.

3. Boost Your Luck by Visiting Temples and Shrines in the Takarazuka area

As you take in the history of the city's time-honored temples and shrines, we'll make a stop at Kiyoshikojin. It is a temple dedicated to the god of fire, and as such, visitors are given hibashi (fire tongs).

4. Tour and Experience of Making Lucky Charms That Bring “FUKU”(Option)

Visit a lucky charms workshop, and learn about their history, construction and cultural relevancy. Participants are encouraged to create original lucky charms here.

Overview

A bevy of sightseeing spots await you, and there is certainly more to come in the Kita-Awaji (North Awaji) area, which is easily accessible from cities like Osaka and Kobe. With Kita-Awaji as a base, visitors can experience first-hand how vegetables are grown harvested in farm. The plan is inspired by the Farm to table concept as well as SDG initiatives. Additionally, guests can visit and interact with Japan's world-class anime and game culture through puzzles and moving their bodies. At night, families can enjoy stargazing from the accommodations specifically selected for the views offered. This plan was designed to spark children's intellectual curiosities while allowing parents and their children to engage in physical activities as a family.

Plan

1. Vegetable Harvesting Experience + Lunch at Farmhouse Restaurant Harusansan

The theme of this farmhouse is "nature's cycle". Set in a venue built from scrap wood, visitors will be taught how to harvest their own food as well as learn about composting in a fashion that is both unusual and nurturing.

2. Nijiken no Mori Family Pass

Choose two attraction that recreate the worlds of some of Japan's most celebrated characters, including but not limited to Dragon Quest, Crayon Shin-Chan, Godzilla, and Naruto. The theme park is designed to challenge its visitors with puzzles, riddles and athletics. There, children can hone their critical thinking skills as well as work up a sweat.

3. Enjoy a stay at GRAND CHARIOT Big Dipper 135°

You can take the shuttle bus directly from Nijigen-no-mori and enjoy the spectacular view of the sunset and starlit sky that only Awaji Island, rich in nature, can offer from your room. BBQ (summer only) dinners held on the terrace include vegetables harvested during the day.

Overview

This is a one of a kind experience geared to provoke your thoughts on health and the world as a whole. It is not your typical horseback riding lesson. Whether you are starting from zero experience, our objective is to guide you towards bonding with your horse so that you may roam through gardens, along beaches or an original course. Our relationship with animals can and should be reconsidered, perhaps this package will inspire you to do so.

Plan

1. Meet your Partner Horses

First you will be matched to your partner horse based on your experience and physique. Once that is settled, you will move on to the stable and begin to learn about your horse's personality through caring for them.

2. Indulge Yourself on a Lecture on Horse Therapy

The lecture will cover the current situation where more than 90% of Japan's racehorses are slaughtered, the positive effects of riding horses on the body and mind, and the return of horse manure to the fields of Awaji, as well as the concept of balancing human health with the health of animals and ultimately the earth.

3. Experience Horseback Riding

Leaving the stable, you will be guided through a vast expanse of land surrounded by fields of flowers. Participants will enjoy the extraordinary healing experience of walking on horseback in the wilderness and learn about the efforts of the natural cycle. Finally, through horseback riding without the assistance of an instructor, participants will experience the difficulty of communicating beyond language and a sense of accomplishment.

A Cruise & Trek to Unearth the Origins of Japan

Get a taste of Nushima, the birthplace of Japan, from land and sea. A local guide residing on the island will provide a lecture on the myths surrounding the origin of Japan.

Overview

Uncover the story of Japan's origin in Nushima, a place steeped in the myth of the birth of the nation as told in Japan's oldest history book. Explore it from both land and sea through the cruise circumnavigating the island and upon its shores. In combination with a lively retelling of the myth by a local guide residing in Nushima, experience a remarkable lunch using Nushima's fresh fish at a restaurant in its fishermen-town.

Plan

1. The Onokoro Cruise

You will begin the excursion by listening to the charming tale of the birth of nations handcrafted by your guide, a local fisherman. After which you will board a fishing boat alongside him for a lap around Nushima (or half a lap depending on the current). The myth takes on a sense of reality as you approach the Kamitate-Gamiwa, the symbol of the myth and the Anaguchi, which is said to be the entrance to the underworld.

2. Take Pleasure in a Lunch Featuring Fresh Local Seafood

Enjoy fresh seafood at a restaurant frequented by local fisherman where you can try Ryoushi-Meshi (fisherman-dishes).

3. Nushima Trekking

This is a trekking tour around the Nushima Island. You will visit Onokoro Shrine then head off to see Kamitate-Gamiwa from the coast. From the landside view you can clearly see a heart-shaped hollow in the rock.

Here, you can receive *hibashi* (fire tongs) to ward off evil spirits as a good luck charm. Please enjoy strolling along the 1km approach lined with local restaurants and souvenir stores along the way.



Option

Visit a lucky charm workshop with 140 years of history to create your own original lucky charm

Visit the workshop of Ebisu Shimada, which actually produces the lucky charms for the guest rooms. After receiving an explanation of the history and production process of lucky charms from an active craftsman, visitors can create their own original lucky charms to take home. If the timing is right, you can also purchase the lucky charms on the spot.

14:00

Explore Nishinomiya Shrine, where lucky charms made in a workshop in Takarazuka are housed

This is the main shrine of Ebisu Shrine, which enshrines Ebisu, the god of good fortune. You can purchase the *o-fuda* sold to visitors to the shrine and put them in an Ebisu Shimada *o-fuda* holder to enjoy the set.

**If you include the Takarazuka - Nishinomiya itinerary in your tour, the o-fuda holder is enclosed in the grab bag.*



18:00

Art Aquarium átoa- Chartered dinner for the senses

Serene seas encapsulated in the largest spherical aquarium in Japan. That is the setting. There you will be served a private Kobe beef dinner course paired with sake from the region, hand-picked by a sommelier. While you eat, enjoy some jazz. As Kobe is the fountainhead of Japan's jazz movement, it only makes sense for it to be the soundtrack to your evening. The player is also from Kobe, so everything you eat, see, hear touch and feel is locally produced.

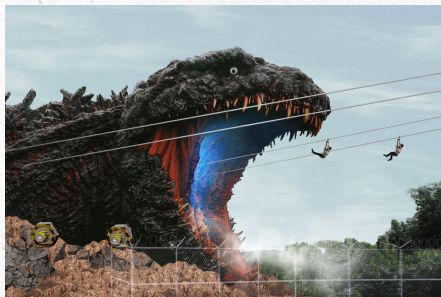
